The Hess Collection, family owned and operated since 1978, has crafted a legacy of excellence in Napa Valley. A pioneer by nature, Donald Hess was determined to defy convention and pursue winemaking in the farthest reaches of Napa Valley. Today, decades-long experience in sustainable viticulture produces wines recognized for their elegance, richness, and complex flavors. Though just 30 miles long and a few miles wide, Napa Valley is home to diverse microclimates and soils uniquely suited to wine grape growing. It is considered one of the premier wine regions in the world.

ALLOMI CABERNET SAUVIGNON

In 1995, Donald Hess sought out the Allomi Vineyard nestled to the east of Howell Mountain with a vision to uncover its potential. Once a dormant beauty, the Allomi Vineyard now gives life to luxury Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon. The 210-acre vineyard is focused into 35 unique growing blocks with six different Cabernet Sauvignon clones that provide a diversity of flavors and complexity to this wine.

TASTE WITH THE WINEMAKER

“The Allomi Vineyard consistently delivers fruit of the highest quality, and this vintage was no different. On the nose, our Allomi Cabernet offers inviting aromas of warm vanilla, strawberry, and cedar, complemented by gentle barrel spice notes of cinnamon and nutmeg. The entry is soft and tea-like, leading into a juicy, fruit-forward palate with hints of cocoa and subtle cedar on the finish. Dusty tannins give way to velvety vanilla and berry flavors, creating a smooth, lingering finish — a perfect reminder of why this is one of our most popular Napa offerings.”

VINTAGE NOTES

Vintage 2023 is characterized as one of the longest growing seasons in a decade. The mild weather led to above-average crop yields. With all of the heavy winter rains, the reservoirs were full and soils saturated. The winter rains gave the vines much needed hydration as they woke up from their dormant winter. Cool weather and sunshine enabled a slow maturity for deep vibrant flavors.
